Remembering John Ruse - 27th July 1931 to 10th May 2025

John Ruse suffered from a long illness and recently had a fall. He was admitted to Maroondah Hospital and sadly passed away on 10th May. A Memorial Service was held on the 21st May at William Matthews Funerals Lilydale, which was well attended by Family and friends and EPR Members.

Pauline asked Judy as President of EPR, to give a talk about EPR. Judy was very happy to do so.

"John and Pauline Ruse have been Members of EPR for the last 40 years or more. They were not only members: They were Leaders of EPR, along with Leo and Barbara Mioni, June and Ron Ginger, Eda and Lou Ashworth. June Ginger organised Bus Trips with John and Leo helping with the Members. The Bus Trips, travelled all over Australia, to Darwin the Northan Territory, across the Nullarbor to Perth. They also have been up the East Coast of N.S.W. and Queensland. They also have toured around Victoria, even ventured to New Zealand and other places.

When 4C's – (Caravans, Cabins, Camping and Companionship) started, Members over the years, travelled all over Victoria. John Ruse made the "Bright Spark Award" to present to people who performed the best at the Traditional Concert held on the last night of the camp. John handmade different awards each time. Each award was crafted in timber, magnificently designed with a "Sparkplug" centred in the middle of the award.

John enjoyed making his awards at home in his tool shed, where he also made the props for the Shows. He repainted chairs, made the Bar for the Stage which was a great success. John also made the Scenery Stage Flats for each Show. He also enjoyed working Back Stage on Spotlighters and Etag. He made sure everyone was on time and kept the performers in line.

At a *Christmas in July* Event John Ruse was presented his 80th Birthday Cake, by "The Mystery Lady" in Masquerade (June Ginger), who also presented John an Award from E.P.R. for his contribution over the years. This included all the work that he loved to do for EPR. The Lectern standing in the Studio was made by John. He also put the wheels on the piano to easily move it around. John also did the same with the barbie, he put wheels on it to move around, especially for Bocce and was a great help to Leo. John made a special surprise, a Royal Throne for "Monsignor Luigi Mioni" (Leo) reaching his 80th Birthday at his "Italian Night" on Sat. May 8th 2010.

In October, 2011 John placed the Royal Throne on the Stage in the Seniors Main Hall for Pauline's Coronation, for the 1st Chapter of the EPR Red Hats, "The High Blushers". I had the honour of Crowning Pauline "Queen of Sheba" while Her Majesty sat on the Royal Throne in all of her Regalia.

For quite a few years, Ray and I enjoyed meeting John and Pauline at the Club Ringwood on Sunday Morning for Coffee. Leo and Barbara Mioni, Eda Ashworth and June Ginger were regular Members, along with others who enjoyed our Sunday Morning.

John will be sadly missed, not only by his family, but members and friends of EPR."

Do come along, bring a friend and join in the fun with a welcome cuppa to follow.


